He has appeared 10 times at the Just For Laughs Festival in Montreal, penned scripts for a variety of award-winning television shows ("Popular Mechanics for Kids," "Prank Patrol," etc.), written three critically-acclaimed books of original close-up magic (*Natural Selections I*, *Natural Selections II*, and *Random Acts of Magic*), and he is currently the co-host and co-writer of Discovery Kids' hit series, *Mystery Hunters*, for which he received a Gemini nomination (Best Writing in a Children's Series). In addition, David is at work writing a *Mystery Hunters* book for KidsCan Press, featuring a collection of tricks and hoaxes kids can unleash on their friends!
